## Description

Open-access publishing has become one of the requirements of most public research funding bodies, but also of the URV.

The assistant is provided with the contents related to the publication of the research in open access, the deposit in the institutional repository, the policies and regulations related to the publication in open access. It will also address the link between the researcher's CV and IRIS and the institutional repository with the Research Portal of Catalonia.

## Objectives and learning results

At the end of the session the assistant will be able to:

- Define the key concepts in the field of open access.
- Identify the different ways to publish in open access.
- Differentiate the versions of an article at each moment of the publication process.
- Implement the different initiatives, policies and regulations on open access at institutional, national and European level.

- Evaluate the different possibilities of co-financing APC (Article Processing Charge) costs.

## Methodology

Asynchronous virtual self-learning course, held within the Virtual Campus of the URV, which provides autonomous work and temporal independence for the consolidation of the contents.

- Theoretical activities, where the contents will be worked on, with directed readings or viewing of audiovisual material.
- Self-assessment activities.
